FUNDRAISING ADVENTURE CHALLENGE

PARIS TO LONDON CYCLE, JULY 2015



In July 2015, 24 employees from [Dassault Systemes](#), a multinational software company, cycled from their headquarters in Paris to London. Over four days they cycled 275 miles together through Northern France, crossed over the English Channel by ferry then cycled through Southern England to London.

The team secured individual and group sponsorship for completing the ride and [fundraised over £10,000](#) for the [Princes Trust](#).

There were various abilities and experience in the group, so **teamwork**, **tolerance** and **communication** throughout the team proved essential elements of what proved to be an extremely successful trip.
